1. Jesus Became Poor So We Might Become Rich



2 Corinthians 8:9 (NKJV)

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though **He was rich**, yet for your sakes **He became poor**, that **you through His poverty might become rich**.



2. Blessed to Be a Blessing (Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Job)



Genesis 12:2–3 (NKJV)

²I will make you a great nation; **I will bless you** And make your name great; And **you shall be a blessing.**

³I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you **all the families of the earth shall be blessed.**



Genesis 13:2 (NKJV)

Abram was **very rich** in livestock, in silver, and in gold.



Genesis 13:6 (NKJV)

Now the land was not able to support them, that they might dwell together, for **their possessions were so great** that they could not dwell together.



Genesis 26:12–14 (NKJV)

¹² Then Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year **a hundredfold**; and **the Lord blessed him**.

¹³ The man began to prosper, and continued prospering until he **became very prosperous**;

¹⁴ for he had possessions of flocks and possessions of herds and a great number of servants.



Genesis 26:12–14 (NKJV)

So the Philistines envied him.



Genesis 30:43 (NKJV)

Thus the man became **exceedingly prosperous**, and had large flocks, female and male servants, and camels and donkeys.



Job 42:12 (NKJV)

Now **the Lord blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning**; for he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, one thousand yoke of oxen, and one thousand female donkeys.

4. Shows the Lord is with you



Genesis 26:28 (NKJV)

But they said, "We have certainly seen that **the Lord is with you**. So we said, 'Let there now be an oath between us, between you and us; and let us make a covenant with you,



Genesis 39:3 (NKJV)

And his master saw that **the Lord was with him** and that the Lord made all he did to **prosper in his hand.**



Genesis 45:26–28 (NKJV)

²⁶ And they told him, saying, "**Joseph is still alive, and he is governor over all the land of Egypt.**" And Jacob's heart stood still, because he did not believe them.

²⁷ But when they told him all the words which Joseph had said to them, and when he saw the carts which Joseph had sent to carry him, **the spirit of Jacob their father revived.**

²⁸ Then Israel said, "It is enough.

Genesis 45:26–28 (NKJV)

Joseph my son is still alive. I will go and see him before I die."

How to Become Rich?



1. Tithe



מַעֲשֵׂר (ma'ăšēr) – tithe, tenth part

עָשַׂר ('āšar) – to be or become rich, to make rich



Malachi 3:10 (NKJV)

Bring all the tithes into the storehouse,
That there may be food in My house, And
try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts,
"If I will not **open for you the windows of
heaven** And **pour out for you such blessing**
That there will not be room enough to
receive it.



Proverbs 3:9–10 (NKJV)

⁹ **Honor the Lord with your possessions,**
And with the firstfruits of all your increase;
¹⁰ **So your barns will be filled with plenty,**
And your vats will overflow with new wine.



Deuteronomy 8:18 (NKJV)

And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is **He who gives you power to get wealth**, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.



**2. Sow Sparingly, Reap
Sparingly — Sow Bountifully**



2 Corinthians 9:6 (NKJV)

But this I say: He who **sows sparingly will also reap sparingly**, and he who **sows bountifully will also reap bountifully**.



2 Corinthians 9:8 (NKJV)

And God is able to make **all grace abound toward you**, that you, always having **all sufficiency in all things**, may have an abundance for every good work.



Luke 6:38 (NKJV)

Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.



Benefits of Tithing / Offering



1. To Prove That Jesus Is Alive (Melchizedek)



Hebrews 7:8 (NKJV)

Here mortal men receive tithes, but there **he receives them**, of whom it is witnessed that **he lives**.



Genesis 14:18–20 (NKJV)

¹⁸ Then **Melchizedek** king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the **priest of God Most High.**

¹⁹ And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth;

²⁰ And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand."
And **he gave him a tithe of all.**

**2. To Show That God Is the
One Who Made You Rich**



Genesis 14:22–23 (NKJV)

²² But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have raised my hand to the Lord, God Most High, **the Possessor of heaven and earth,**
²³ that I will take nothing, from a thread to a sandal strap, and that I will not take anything that is yours, lest you should say, '**I have made Abram rich**'"



3. By Faith Abel Offered



Hebrews 11:4 (NKJV)

By faith Abel offered to God **a more excellent sacrifice** than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it **he being dead still speaks.**



4. To Find Where Your Heart Is



Matthew 6:21 (NKJV)

For **where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.**



Mark 12:41–44 (NKJV) - Part 1

⁴¹ Now Jesus sat opposite the treasury and **saw how the people put money** into the treasury. And many who were rich put in much.

⁴² Then **one poor widow** came and threw in **two mites**, which make a quadrans.



Mark 12:41–44 (NKJV) - Part 2

⁴³So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that **this poor widow has put in more** than all those who have given to the treasury;
⁴⁴for they all put in out of their abundance, but **she out of her poverty put in all that she had**, her whole livelihood."



5. Honor God With Your Money



Proverbs 3:9–10 (NKJV)

⁹ **Honor the Lord with your possessions,**
And with the **firstfruits of all your increase;**
¹⁰ So your barns will be filled with plenty,
And your vats will overflow with new wine.



6. To Come Out of Debt (Elisha and the Widow)



2 Kings 4:6–7 (NKJV)

⁶Now it came to pass, when **the vessels were full**, that she said to her son, "Bring me another vessel." And he said to her, "There is not another vessel." So the oil ceased.

⁷And she came and told the man of God.



2 Kings 4:6–7 (NKJV)

And he said, "**Go, sell the oil and pay your debt**; and you and your sons live on the rest."

1 Corinthians 3:1–2 (NKJV)

²I fed you with **milk and not with solid food**; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able;



Hebrews 5:13–14 (NKJV)

¹³ For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.

¹⁴ But **solid food belongs to those who are of full age**, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

1 Timothy 6:6–8 (NKJV)

⁶Now **godliness with contentment is great gain.**

⁷For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.

⁸And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content.



1 Timothy 6:9–10 (NKJV)

⁹ But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition.

¹⁰ For **the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil**, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.



1 Timothy 6:17–19 (NKJV)
